e-Learning Policy

Per the state of South Carolina Department of Education and in collaboration with the South Carolina Public Charter School District, Learn4Life High School-Charleston has been approved for e-Learning Days. This means, in the event of severe weather events or other interruptions (power outage, gas leaks, etc.) that are disruptive to the learning day effecting regular daily attendance for instruction, Learn4Life will implement an e-Learning model that includes virtual face-to-face instruction using Google Meets and an office hour structure for each content area to provide instruction as well as our online platform. Each designated e-Learning day, will be decided with careful consideration of the safety of students and the feasibility of instruction in the in-person model.

A final decision will be made based on local and national news reports, as well as information provided from the state of South Carolina and city of North Charleston, in collaboration with the management company. Designated e-Learning schools are allowed to use up to five days of instruction as e-Learning Days (not pre-planned) in response to severe weather or other unpredictable events that disrupt the regular in-person learning model.

e-Learning Structure/Schedule

Our e-Learning structure includes virtual face-to-face instruction using Google Meets. Teachers will meet with students in the Advisory Google Classroom at 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM in our Friday's Advisory structure. Teachers will provide specific guidance and directions to students for how to navigate their school schedule and receive learning support. The instructional plan and schedule will be posted and available in each teachers Google Classroom and on the website for ease of access to students and parents.

Student Learning Resources

All students have been issued a chromebook for use at home. Students are expected to take their chromebook home and return to school with it daily. Student accounts are set up with access to email, internet, learning applications, and Google drive (Google Classroom, Google Meets, etc.). Learn4Life uses Google suit as the primary Learning Management System used to connect teachers and students via Google Classroom and Google Meets. Google Drive will be the platform use to provide live as well as pre-recorded instruction to our scholars. Our curriculum is structured in learning packets that students take home with them and are available online in Google Classroom, which allows them access to the curriculum without hauling books. We also provide a tutoring service via chat, email and text for students to receive additional support during and after school hours. Some of our courses are provided using Edmentum, an online curriculum resource that all students have access to.
