Updated eLearning Days Plan 2025-2026

Learn4Life High School-Charleston is designated as an eLearning School. Those schools who meet the criteria for an eLearning School as determined by the Department of Education may use up to five eLearning days to allow for the make-up of short-term disruptions to in-person teaching and learning.

Expectations

Our e-Learning structure includes (1) virtual face-to-face instruction via Google Meets, (2) Independent Learn@Home learning using the packet-base curriculum, and (3) Independent online coursework. Teachers will meet with students in the Advisory Google Classroom at 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM mirroring our Friday's Learn@Home structure. Teachers will provide specific guidance and directions to students for how to navigate their school schedule and receive academic support.

- Students should check in with their advisor via Google Meets at 8:00AM (AM cohort) and 12:00PM (PM cohort).
- Students have packet-based curriculum and an assigned school Chromebook to access online curriculum and should complete from home based on assignment due.
- Attendance will be taken for ALL students, based on their access to this learning modalities on an eLearning day.

The eLearning schedule will be posted and available in each teachers Google Classroom and on the website (learn4lifecharleston.org) for ease of access to students and parents.

Access to the Google Classroom - ALL students are assigned a Chromebook upon enrollment and should use the assigned technology device to access the Google Classroom platform. Google Classroom is easily accessed from the single sign-on via student Clever page. Students are expected to join the Google Classroom and will also receive an invite from their teacher. Students can access instructions, messages, live video/chat meetings and resources through Google Classroom. Google Classroom can also be accessed on any internet-ready device.

Schedule

The schedule below is an overview of the schedule that will be used during eLearning Days. We will update parents asap, if the schedule or times change.



Communication

Students and parents will be notified via phone, text and email blast using School Messenger, our communications systems, daily announcements board in Power School. Troubleshooting

If students have technology issues with their Chromebook, there are several ways to get support.

Special Programs

All teachers and educational aides are pre-scheduled for online instructional time during eLearning Days. This will allow students to access instructional support in every content area to provide academic support to all students. Additionally, behavior support and school counselor are available to provide assistance to students who need SEL support.

Students with disabilities (IEP/504/EL) will receive educational service time via online instruction, or teleservices by providers (OT, PT, Psych) during eLearning Days, and will continue to receive accommodations from their general education teacher using the online Google Meets and Google Classroom platforms. Any services not rendered, due to power outage, etc., with be rescheduled for the first date available on the provider's schedule.

CTE students attending the Dorchester County Career and Technical Center (DCCTC) for CTE programming are not required to attend during designated eLearning Days at Learn4Life High School-Charleston. If DCCTC is still in session, the student participants attendance will not count against them. Parents and students will have discretion to attend the program on eLearning days, if DCCTC is open, but would not be required because we provide daily primary transportation to the partner site.
